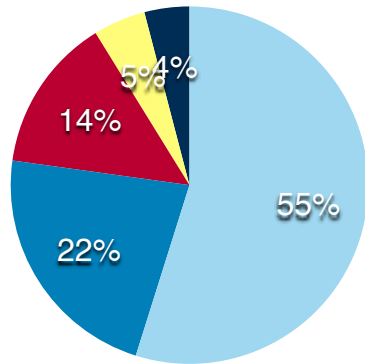







# Spirit Radio Public Financials

Spirit Radio is a charity and committed to the highest standards of financial accountability. This page is intended to provide a readily understandable outline of our financial situation. Our accounts are audited annually by DCA Chartered Accountants and can be viewed on the Companies Registration Office website.

## Outgoings

Spirit Radio is broadcasting on FM from 7 locations and Medium Wave from 1 location. There are 40 people involved in running the station — 4 full time, 16 part time & 20 volunteers. It costs €37,000 monthly to keep the station on air. The CEO is paid less than €30k p.a.

Spirit Radio has two main sources of income: **listener support** and **advertising revenue**. The team at Spirit Radio are working hard to grow both listener support and advertising revenue.

Our immediate goal is to see a further 1500 listeners join the supporters team and help bring Good News radio to the people of Ireland.
